

The bark from Daphne Cannabina or Daphne Papyracea is the raw material used in making the Nepali rice paper that has been produced by craftsmen for over a thousand years. It is known for its exceptional durability and for its lively and special texture and is the namesake for our wallcovering design Daphne<sup>®</sup>. These characteristics also apply to the wallcovering, although ours has what looks to be a lacquer finish applied over the surface.
